

Your Zero Harm Statistics

Introduction

The website shows **your** personal Zero Harm statistics in relation to the whole company average. The following definitions explain how we calculate these figures.

Definitions

Lost Time Incidents

Your Statistics - The total Lost Time Incidents you have had during the last 12 months. Company Statistics is calculated in the same way - the total Lost Time Incidents the Company had during the last 12 months. This is updated monthly.

Road Traffic Collision Ratio per 100,000kms

This statistic is used widely by the Transport Industry. To calculate this, we total RTC Incidents you have recorded over the last 5 years. We also total the number of kilometres you have driven. If the total kilometres driven is less (or more) than 100,000, we pro-rata the ratio to work out what the ratio would be over 100,000. This is updated monthly

Example:

Fred has recorded 3 RTCs in the last 3 years. During that time, he drove 20,000kms on HET Tasks and 30,000 on 3PR, a total of 50,000. If Fred has 3 RTCs over 50,000, his rate per 100,000 is therefore 6.

HSE Incidents

Any type of HSE incident that you have been involved in, including near miss, minor incidents that DID NOT result in lost time on either HET or 3Pr. Data is for the previous 12 months (rolling year)

Injuries to Public

Any incident that involved a member of the public being injured as a result of our activities either on HET or on 3PR. Data is for the previous 12 months (rolling year)

High Potential Incidents

Any incident, including environmental, that has the potential for serious injury or extensive damage to the environment on HET or 3PR. Data is for the previous 12 months (rolling year)
